## **Lands Management Training Opportunity**

The Little Shuswap Lake Indian Band is seeking applications from Band members who may be interested in a future in Land Management position.

The applicant must have sufficient education qualifications to enroll in the Indigenous Peoples Resource Management Program at the University of Saskatchewan. More information is available on the College of Agriculture and Bio-resources website at the University of Saskatchewan.

This involves three two week trips to Saskatoon over the course of the year.

Upon successful completion of this program, individuals will enroll in the National Aboriginal Land Managers Association (NALMA) training program.

This involves five one week trips anywhere in Canada and one week of on-line schooling.

Successful completion of these training components certifies you as a Lands Manager.

**Individuals must be a Little Shuswap Lake band member.**

Applicants are required to submit a copy of the Dogwood diploma.

Individuals must have valid driver's license and have access to serviceable vehicle.
